Cobb woman sues drug treatment center

The American Civil Liberties Union has filed a lawsuit in U.S. District Court seeking \$500,000 for a Cobb County woman who says she was held against her will and abused at a Marietta drug treatment facility known as Straight Inc.

The suit was filed Monday on behalf of Susan 1, 19, who says she was the victim of medical malpractice, false imprisonment, fraud and assault during the 11 months she was held in the Florida-based drug

rehabilitation program.

The suit also alleges that Straight Inc. is not properly licensed as a drug treatment program in Georgia and that its members are not properly trained to treat drug abusers, said ACLU President Bruce Morris at a news conference.

Dennis Buttimer, director of the Straight Inc. facility in Marietta, said he had no formal notification of the

- suit and therefore declined to comment.
