STATE LICENSE. Straight Inc., a drug treatment program in Orlando, received a one-year license Thursday to continue operating, a spokesman for the Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services said. Straight had been operating under a three-month temporary license that expired Thursday. The new license was issued after Straight changed its restraint policy. It had used a method, unacceptable to the state, in which four clients pin an unruly client to the floor to prevent him from injuring himself or others. Under the new policy, only trained staffers will restrain clients.
