# Statistical Review of The Seed, Inc.

The Division of Youth Services Court statistics shown below are for the purpose of giving an overall picture of The Seed and the job it has undertaken during the past year, 1972, and January and February, 1973, for the rehabilitation of the young people with drug problems. These figures reflect such information as: 1) number of participants; 2) drug abuse history; 3) law involvement; and 4) age factor.

#### Referral Source:

The following indicates the referral source of clients who are and have participated in The Seed program for a period of fourteen months. Some clients have been referred through private sources although they were on probation and modification of court orders are then sent to The Seed program.

The Dade Co. youths have been referred to the Seed originating last March, 1972 to the present date. Broward Co. was referring youths to Seed as of last January, 1972. The above information indicates that the court system, and division of youth services directed by Mr. H. Hollman in Dade County, has established with The Seed, a degree of cooperation that enabled The Seed to date to effectively rehabilitate many youths who might otherwise be dependent upon the State of Florida.
